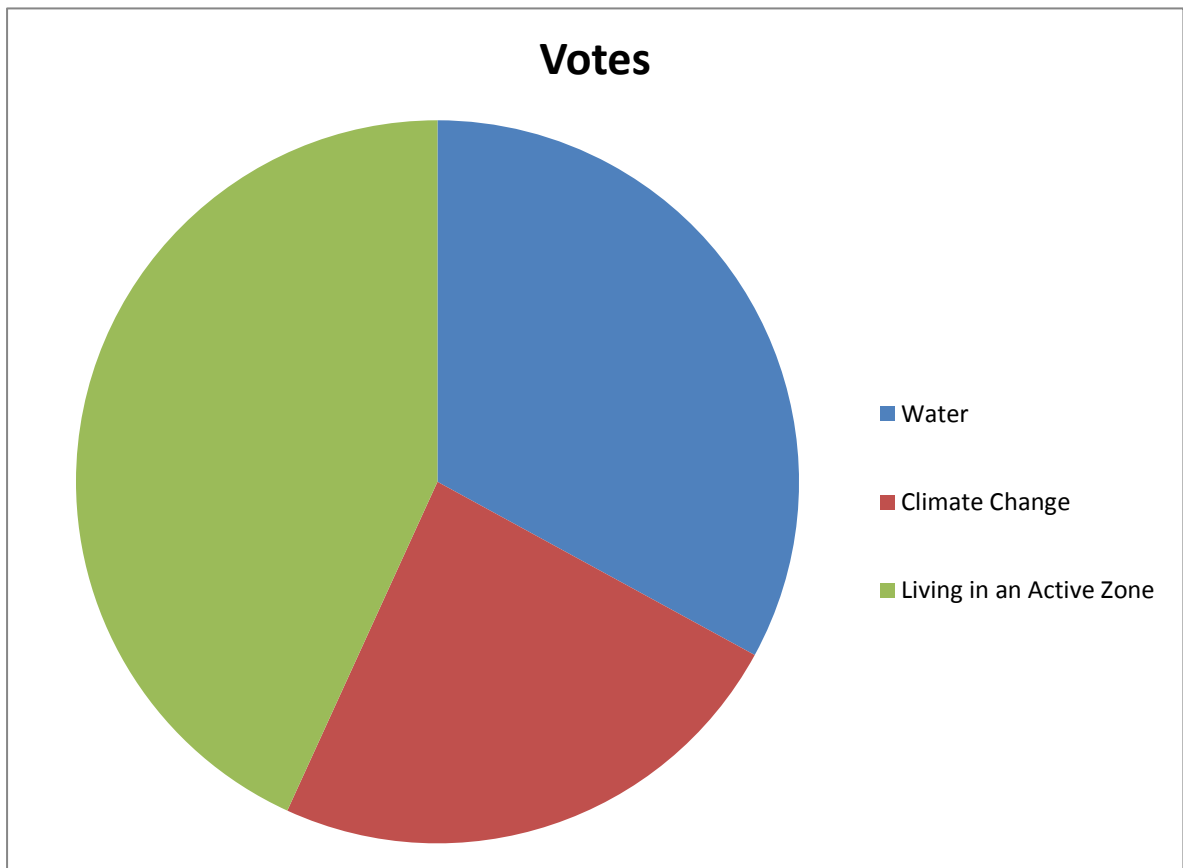

#### Which parts of the course you have enjoyed the most?

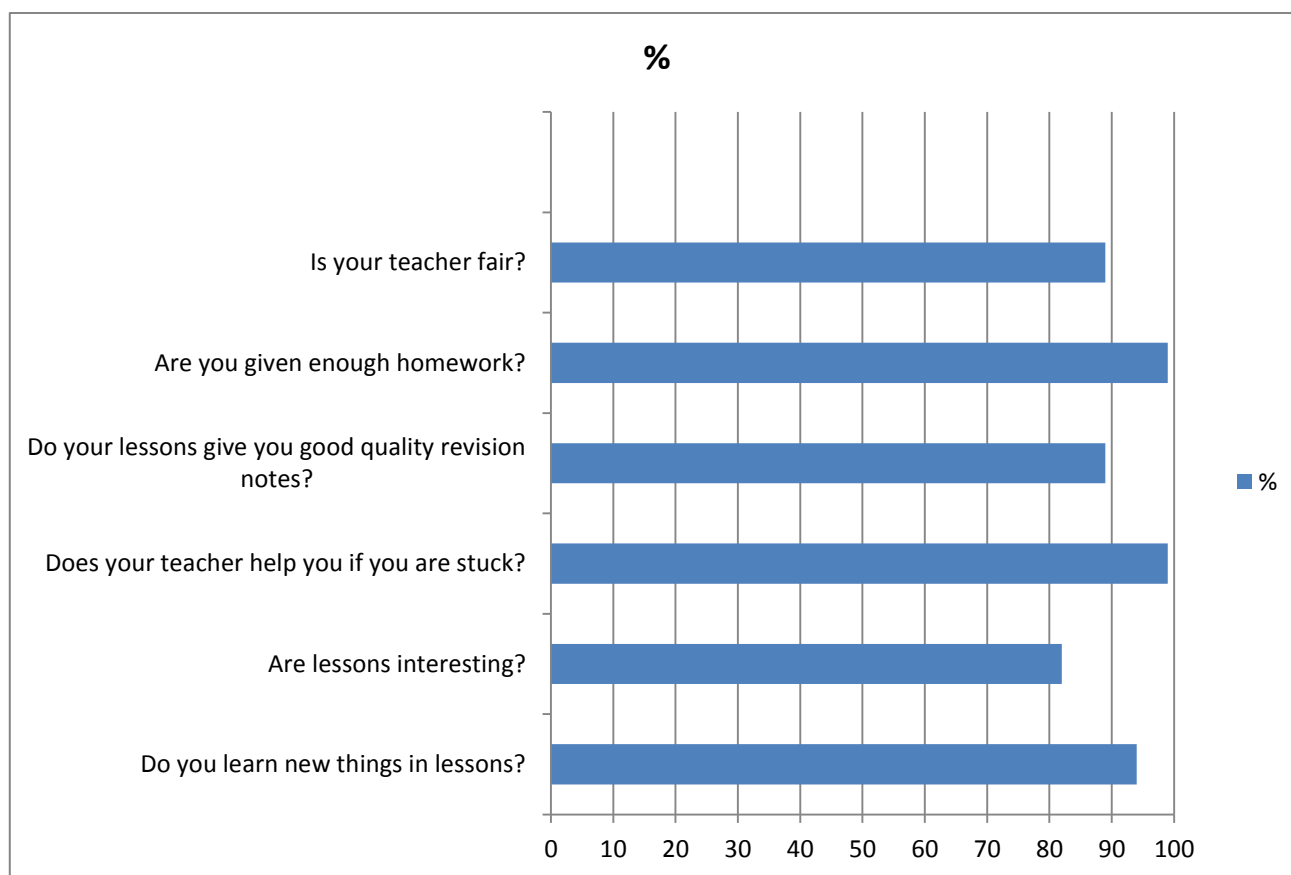

## Quality of teaching (six most significant indicators used).

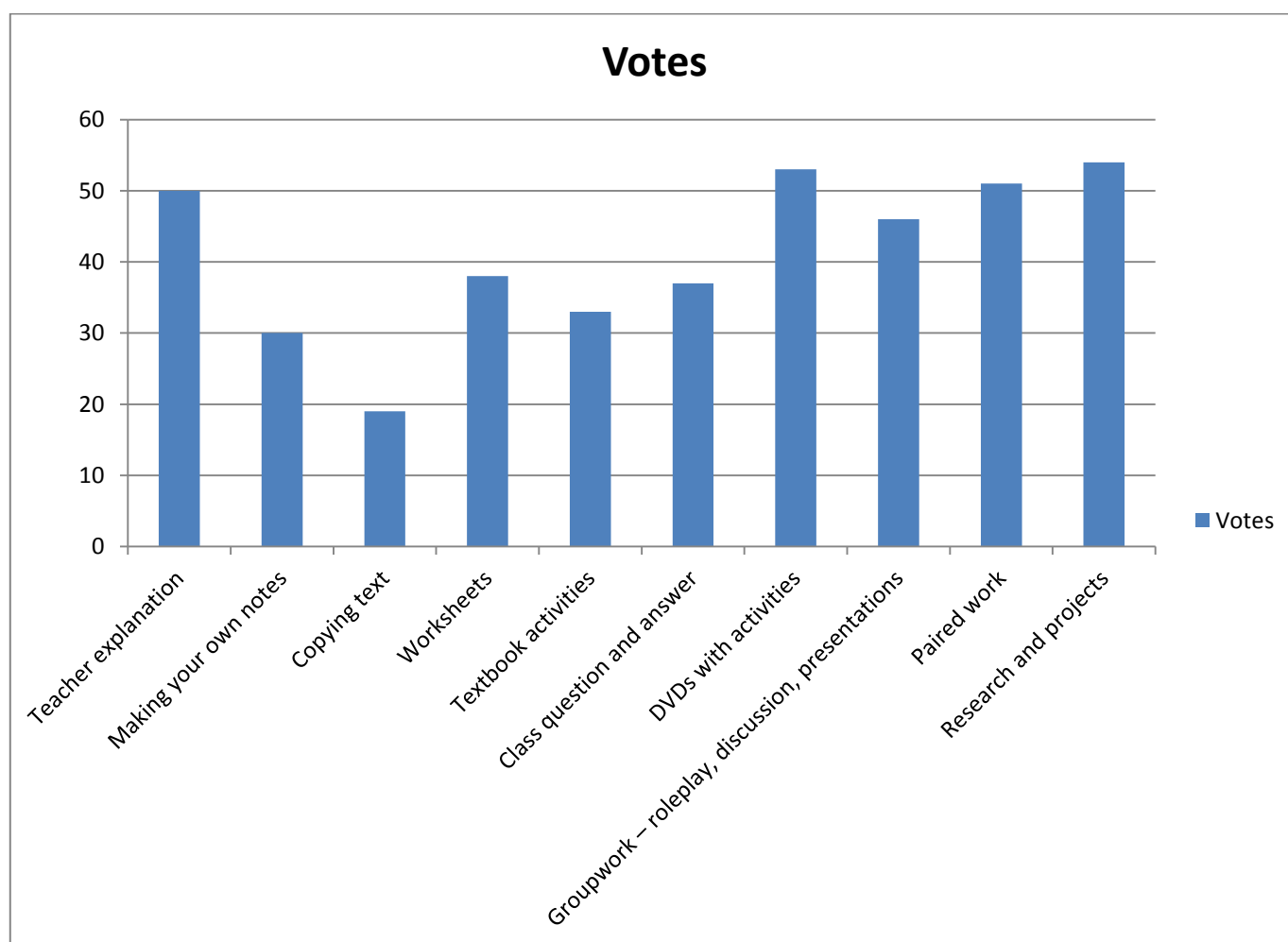

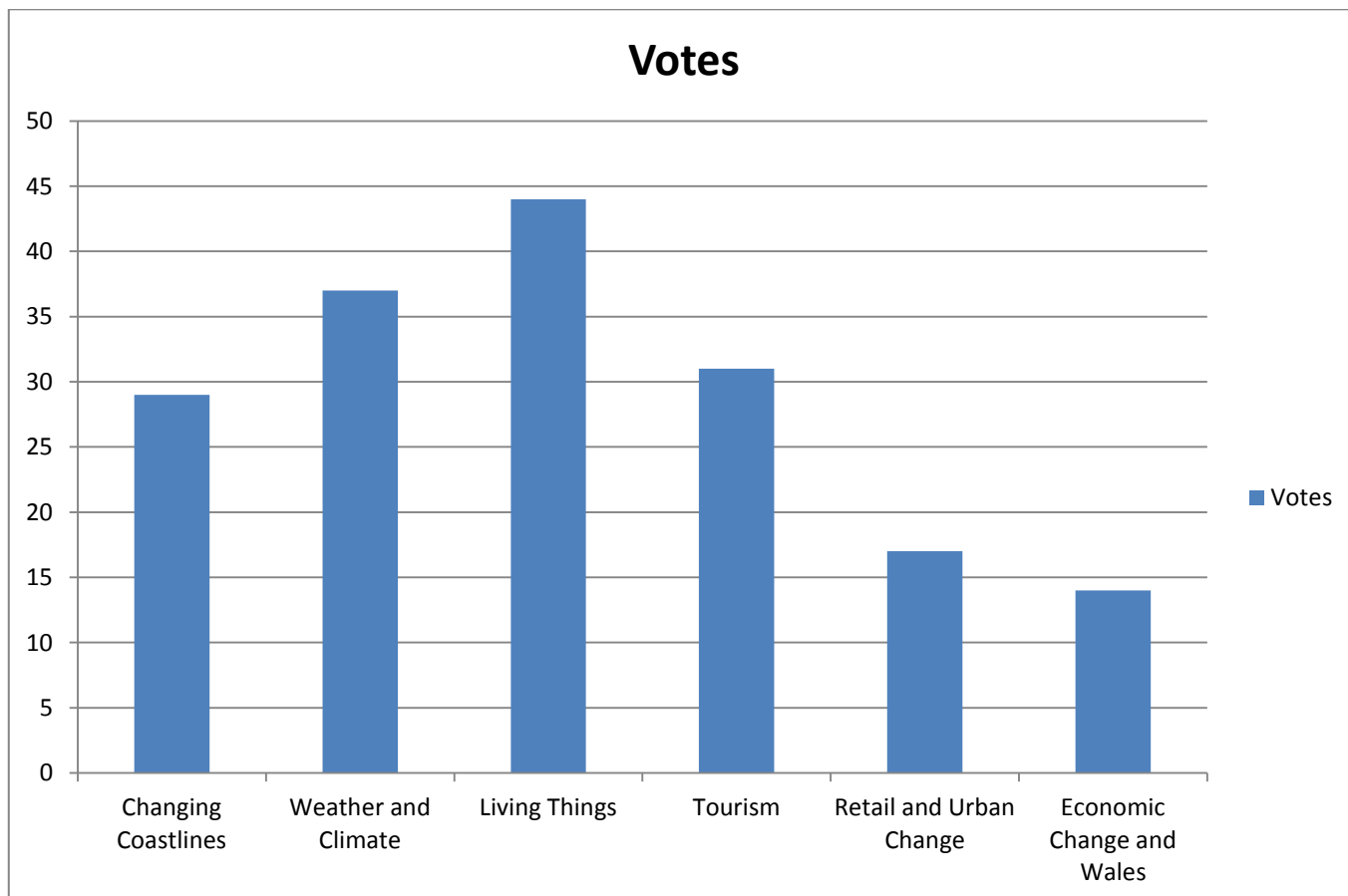
Students who gave each learning activity a score of 7 or above were counted.
